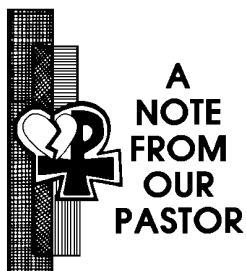

Dear Friends,

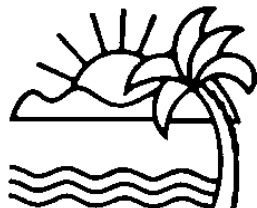
Battling the humidity and heat of the past week has set my mind toward a couple of parish trips for next year. The first of these will take us to the northern national parks – specifically in Utah, Wyoming and Idaho. I'll be looking forward to cool spring temperatures as we relax in Snow King Lodge in Jackson Hole, Wyoming, and take day trips to enjoy the vistas of the Grand Tetons and Yellowstone National Park. Hopefully many of you will join me as we explore the Oregon Trail, and it becomes a lot more real for us than the computer game we know and love. Planned departure is Friday, May 27, 2011, returning on Friday, June 3. Per person rates begin at a very reasonable \$1,999 pp/do. Check with me for a brochure and more information.

Planning ahead, I want to invite you on a very special late fall pilgrimage to Israel from Nov. 2-10, 2011. The price on this trip was recently lowered by \$300, making it reasonably affordable at \$2,799 pp/do. The itinerary will take us to many sites not usually included in Holy Land journeys, including a wonderful optional 9-hour trip to Jericho, Masada, Qumran and the Dead Sea. While covering many of the major biblical sites, where we will actually experience the Scriptures as they come alive, there are additional locations such as Tel Dan in the Golan Heights, Tel Aviv, and Caesarea on the Mediterranean Sea. Again, for more information and brochures, see me and I'll be glad to oblige you! Both of our trips are sponsored by Colette Tours and Blessed John XXIII Parish receives a commission for each trip purchased.
